Return! Returning to school. Returning to work. Returning to gatherings. Returning to travel. We may be all returning at a different pace, but we are all realizing that as we return things are DIFFERENT.

Church is different too.

It reminds me of a story in the prophet Haggai. The people return to Jerusalem after their exile and they rebuilt the temple...but...guess what – it was different. Did not even compare. God even says,

**“Who is left among you who saw this house in its former glory? How do you see it now?  
Is it nothing in your eyes?” Haggai 2:3**

A pastor I know, who was a missionary for several years, Andrew Jones wrote this:

*“Something to consider. As we emerge from the pandemic entering spaces and situations again that we have not seen or experienced in months, it will feel disorienting. This is a form of culture shock, one that we are all experiencing to some degree right now. Tolkien writes this when Frodo comes back after his quest: ‘There is no real going back. Though I may come to the Shire, it will not seem the same; for I shall not be the same.’ Everyone has changed in this pandemic. You have changed. I have changed. The reason things won’t feel the same is because of this change. They will feel familiar but ever so slightly off in a way that you cannot put your finger on. That’s culture shock. It will likely take some time to adjust. Maybe a year or two. Have grace with yourself and others. There is no going back, but there is going forward.”*

Back to Haggai. What was the Lord’s message to them?

**“Be strong Zerubbabel. Be strong Joshua. (the leaders). Be strong all you people! Work for I AM WITH YOU!”  
Haggai 2:4**

Be strong – there is one thing that did not change. And it is the most important – YOU ARE NOT ALONE! The God who was with you before the pandemic and during the pandemic is the God who is with you now and always. In Him we can be strong even as things are different.

**“The latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former...and in this place I will give peace!”  
Haggai 2:9**

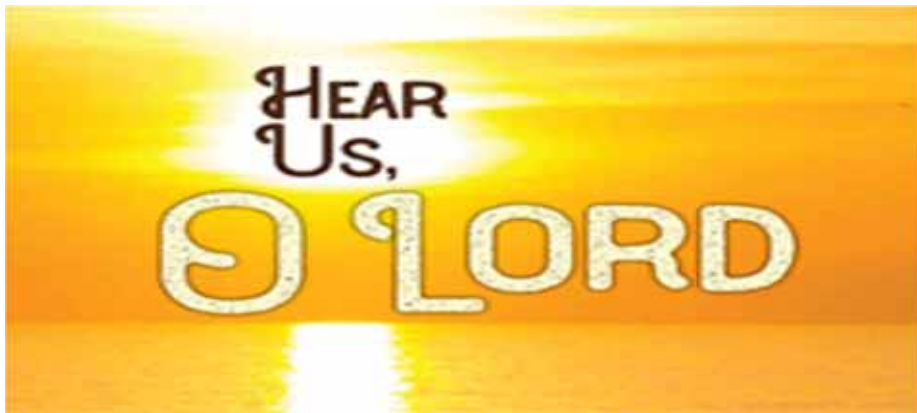
In the Lord’s house, His temple He gives peace. The temple was the place where He gave His peace. God’s peace is what they need and what we need today. He makes clear where to find it. In His Temple and now in the greater temple – Jesus!

Finally, Haggai starts this way “In the second year of the sixth month” God’s Word came to them to build the temple. They returned to the new normal with the practice of worship missing...have you? They returned to the new normal preoccupied in all the other things...have you? They missed the one thing that mattered most...have you?

Let us not wait two years and six months as they did to prioritize what matters most. Return to church – where Jesus is waiting and gives His peace. For some this is in-person for some this is recommitting to online! Do not wait! Return to God’s Word – where Jesus is waiting with His peace. Return to His people – where Jesus is waiting to share His peace. Return to prayer where Jesus is waiting with His peace. Return to Jesus our peace!

**And the Peace of God which transcends our human understand will guard your hearts and minds  
in Christ Jesus! Amen! Philippians 4:7**

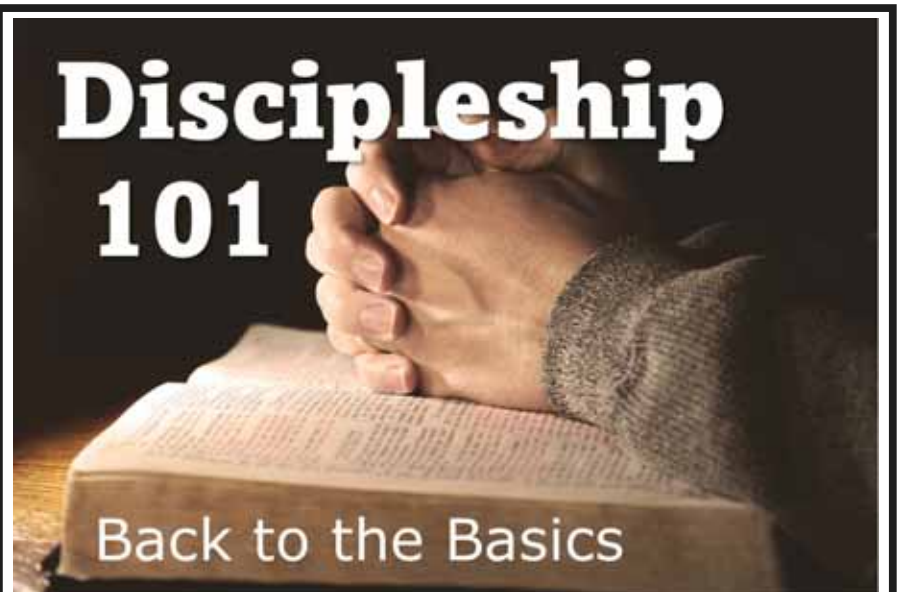

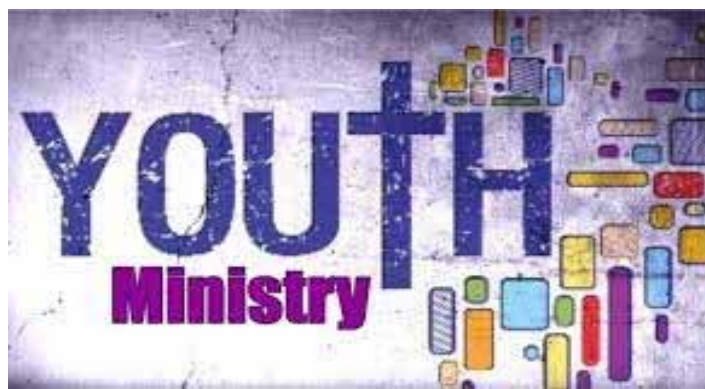

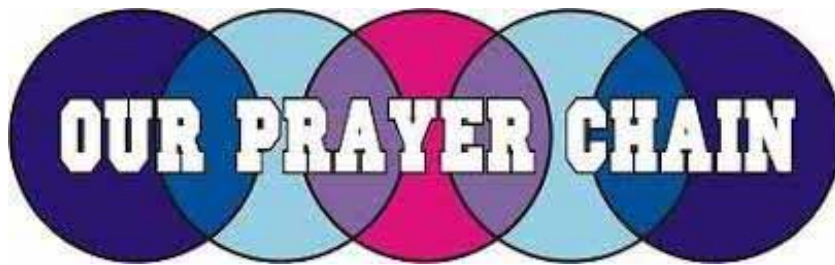

- **Weekly Offering Envelopes!** These are available to all members of Redeemer. They can be submitted during worship, dropped off during the week, or mailed to the church office. If you need envelopes, please contact the church office 507-289-5147.
- **Automatic checking/savings Withdrawals!** Offerings are withdrawn from your checking or savings account and deposited into a Redeemer account. You choose the account, the amount, and the frequency — which can be changed or updated as needed. Contact the church office to get signed up.
- **Give online!** Go to the Redeemer website ([www.redeemer-rochester.com](http://www.redeemer-rochester.com)) and click on the tab "Online Giving" and follow the instructions.
- **Use the "GivePlus" app!** This allows you to make your contributions to Redeemer right from your cell phone! This free app can be downloaded from the app store on your cell phone.
- **Do a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA!** If your age is 70 1/2 or greater, this is a great option for you! Certain IRA holders have the opportunity to make tax-free distributions from their IRAs to qualified charitable organizations. For tax-free eligibility, the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) must be sent directly from the IRA payable to Redeemer. The distribution may be processed by the IRA custodian or by the IRA owner via check writing.

## Our Mites at Work: 🙏

The MN South LWML District Mission Grant focus for the month of August is - **Connecting People in an Inclusive Christian Housing Community** - \$10,000, Bethesda. Cornerstone Village, Victoria, Minnesota, is a new housing community that will provide an active Christian living environment for active seniors and independent adults with disabilities. Construction will be completed in late summer of 2020. Bethesda Lutheran Communities will offer inclusive programs for active seniors and independent adults with disabilities to have an opportunity to make connections and develop friendships as they learn new skills, explore new hobbies and begin or continue their journey of faith in Christ Jesus. This grant will aid in employing an activities manager and funding social and faith-based programming so seniors and people with disabilities may have the opportunity to be active in an inclusive community of faith.
