Key Scripture

Main Takeaway

Be thankful for what God IS providing, instead of grumbling about what He is NOT providing.

Start Talking:

What have you asked for, and then when you received it, you became sick of it?

Start Praying:


Heavenly Father, you provide and yet we grumble. You love and yet we grumble. You care for us and yet we grumble. Help replace our grumbling with gratitude, especially as we journey through times of struggle. Amen.

Start Studying:

1. Read Key Text: What does God mean by “is my arm too short?” What is God’s track record that reminds us we can trust Him, even in the wilderness?
2. 1 Corinthians 10:8-11: Who ultimately are we sinning against when we grumble? Why?
3. Psalm 106:24-26: A summary of Numbers. Grumbling stemmed from two issues? What were they?
4. Philippians 2:12-18: Why is God asking us not to grumble? Why does it stick out like a sore thumb in this world?

Start Applying:

1. If grumbling is an indicator of our sinful nature, why do we not take it more seriously?
2. When left unchecked what does it do to our hearts and faith?
3. Where do you feel like you are being called to combat against the constant narrative in the world of grumbling?
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:18: Who is someone you know who lives this way? What resonates with you? What is one concrete action you can take this week to move from grumbling to gratitude?
