Start Praying:



Start Studying:

1. Read Key Text: Like a relay there are specific baton handoffs. What does one generation do? How does the next respond?
2. Read Romans 10:13-15: What do people need to hear to be saved? What needs to happen for them to hear it?
3. Read 1 Cor 15:1-4: This is a basic summary of the message we share. What is that message?
4. Read Luke 3:1-6: What causes John the Baptist to proclaim? What is the intended end result of his proclamation?

Start Applying:

1. Read Luke 2:8-20 and put yourselves in the place of the Shepherds.
2. How does the actions of the shepherds inspire us to proclaim? (remember – they were not pastors/theologians but just everyday people watching their flocks at night)
3. How has this Advent and the focus on Ponder and Praise prepared you to Proclaim?
4. Where is God calling you, like the shepherds to return and proclaim the Good News of Great Joy?
5. How will you use Christmas to intentionally create opportunities to proclaim?
